Alternative Voting Method:

The alternative voting method, On Demand Special Ballot, otherwise known as "Vote By Mail", is offered to all electors during the 2022 Municipal and School Board Election. This alternative voting method provides electors the opportunity to cast their vote without physically attending a polling station. On Demand Special Ballot kits will be distributed to pre-registered electors by regular mail. Complete ballots may be returned to the Clerk via regular mail or deposited into a pre-determined Ballot Return Station.

Each qualified elector wishing to utilize this alternative voting method must register with the Clerk. The registration begins September 1, 2022 and concludes September 26, 2022. The registration form is available to pick up at Town Hall or available to download at Pelham 2022 Municipal Election Website.

Are You on the Voters' List?

Revisions to the voters' list may be made up to the close of voting on October 24th. Applications must complete the designated form, be fully and properly completed, and signed by the applicant. Forms may be obtained from the Office of the Clerk, at each polling station at Advance Vote locations, and at every polling place on Voting Day. Clerks Department staff will also be available during the Thursday Pelham Farmers Market throughout September.

A list of eligible voters is available in the Office of the Clerk at the address noted below. To determine if you are on the list from the comfort of your home, go to <https://www.pelham.ca/en/town-hall/2022-municipal-election.aspx?mid=5738#Voter-List> and follow the instructions on screen.

Where Do I Vote?

Voter Notification Packages will be mailed to all eligible voters on the list toward the end of September. The package contains information about when and where you may vote. If you do not receive package, or if the information contained in it is incorrect, please contact the Clerk's office. Voting locations are also listed on the Town's website and noted above.

Use of Tabulator

The Town of Pelham will be utilizing vote tabulating equipment located at each Voting Place to process and tabulate the votes, in accordance with established procedures.
