What is VoterLookup?

MPAC's online web service that allows electors to confirm and update their information for municipal elections

Available year-round, 24 hours a day

Allows eligible electors to:

- confirm or update their information
- add a name to an address
- change their school support for electoral purposes

Municipalities can choose when they would like VoterLookup to redirect users to them



Re-Direct Options

Voterlookup.ca re-direct message to be activated at the time of the Preliminary List of Electors/Voter Notification File extract

- If you select the August 2 Preliminary List of Electors delivery, the redirect message will appear on July 22, 2022
- If you select the August 22 Preliminary List of Electors delivery, the redirect message will appear on August 12, 2022

Voterlookup.ca re-direct message to be activated at the time of the September Exceptions File extract

• If you select this timing option, the redirect message will appear on August 31, 2022.

Why is it Important?

Preliminary
List of Electors (PLE)
Accuracy

More municipalities are using or considering alternative voting methods

MPAC is able to collect owner data for every property through the Land Transfer Statements; these documents do not include data on other occupants

Why is it Important?

Due to declining response rates, paper enumeration forms are no longer mailed out.




