

THE CORPORATION OF THE
TOWN OF PELHAM
BY-LAW #190 (1973)

Being a by-law to designate certain plants as local weeds pursuant to provisions of the Weed Control Act of Ontario.


PURSUANT to Section 8 of the Weed Control Act R.S.O. 1970, Chapter 493, as re-enacted by Section 4 of the Weed Control Amendment Act, 1972, Statutes of Ontario 1972, Chapter 39, the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham hereby enacts as follows:


1. The following plants are designated as a local weed in the Town of Pelham:

- (a) Goldenrod - Solidago spp.
- (b) Burdock

2. This by-law comes into force seven days after the day on which it is approved by the Minister of Agriculture and Food.
