THE CORPORATION OF THE T O W N O F P E L H A M BY-LAW #1583 (1993)

Being a by-law to prohibit the possession of liquor in recreational areas.

WHEREAS Section 35 of the Liquor Licence Act provides that the Council of a municipality may, by by-law, designate a recreational area within the municipality that is owned or controlled by the municipality as a place where the possession of liquor is prohibited;

AND WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the Town of Pelham deems it necessary and advisable to pass a by-law to prohibit the possession of liquor in recreational areas;

NOW THEREFORE THE COUNCIL OF THE CORPORATION OF THE TOWN OF PELHAM ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- (1) THAT the possession of liquor be prohibited in those recreational areas, as designated on Schedule "A" to this by-law.
- (2) THAT Section 1 does not apply to a person in possession of liquor under the authority of a licence or permit or in possession of liquor purchased on a premises in respect of which a licence or permit is issued for any of the recreational areas set out on Schedule "A" to this by-law.
- (3) THAT this by-law shall come into force and effect upon the day of its passing.
